

MJ's House sitting services



Doggie sleep away camp:

\$60 per dog daily for daycare clients, \$80 daily for non-daycare clients. Two daycare dogs from same household \$50 per dog per day. Two non-daycare clients from same household are \$75 each.

Give your dog a vacation as well! They can stay with me and my dogs Lola and Alpine on the Washougal River! Fully fenced/secured yard and large piece of property along the

water for playing and swimming. It's a great place to be a dog!

You can pick up and drop off at my home, we can use daycare as a transfer point, or I can pick up pets from your place and return them there shortly before or after you get home.

Drop off/Pick ups/ and home check ins are an additional \$20 or (\$25 holidays and weekends)

*please review the cancellation policy, waiver, and fill out the questionnaire below before reserving pet sitting dates

*care may be available in your home. Daily rates to stay in your home are \$150 for up to two pets. \$175 for over two pets. This service is not available weekend or holidays.

Vacation Visits/Play Dates \$50

Available Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday currently and occasionally some weekends.

A Day of Play on the river! Join MJ at her home on the river for a day of swimming, playing with her dog Lola and Puppy Alpine, and running around.



Dog Hike! A full day of activity. I take a few dogs at a time on dog friendly hike. It is your choice if you would like them to stay on leash during the hike or leave it to my discretion.

Cat visits are \$20 per visit if you are not particular about the timing. If you want a specific time or two check ins a day, rates increase to \$25 a visit. Holiday check and weekend check ins are an additional \$5. Cat visits are 30 minutes each and include feeding, playing, litter box scooping, and anything else needed!



Free Key pick-up/drop-off. If you can't exchange keys with us at daycare, we can stop by to pick them up or drop them off at no additional charge. (Please note that we prefer not to lock your keys in the house at the end of your stay in case your travel plans change unexpectedly and your dog requires additional care.)

Policies

Cancellation – I am careful to structure my days so your pets get the attention they deserve and I take your reservation seriously. At the time of booking, a 50% down payment is required to hold your dates. This reservation fee is nonrefundable in the event of cancellation

Payment – The remainder of payment is due by cash or check at the start of service (unless this is your first sit with me, if so, payment can be completed when you pick up your pooch).

FAQs:

How far ahead in advance should I book my dogs vacation to assure availability?

As soon as you are sure about your trip dates! There is no timing that will ensure I have availability, the further out you book, the greater the likelihood. However, I frequently have availability even at the last minute, so it never hurts to check. I can also check others staffs availability for you. So even if I am not available, I can usually point you in the direction of someone who is! Since you will need a non-refundable 50% deposit to hold your reservation however, be sure about your dates before booking!

What will my dog need to pack?

I have plenty of bowls and beds and dog toys and treats at my place. All your dog really needs is their leash and collar, food, and feeding instructions. However, if there is something you feel would make your dog more comfortable in my home please don't hesitate to bring it. Fair warning though, it will probably come home covered in husky hair from my ladies.

What if I only want my dog in the secured fenced in area?

Although many dogs enjoy my lower property and it is relatively secure, it is not fully fenced. It is however bordered by the river, dense vegetation, and a steep hill. Most dogs are comfortable and secure there. However, if you would rather your dog not be off leash down there, I can give them access only to my fully fenced side yard or the lower property only on leash. Just let me know what makes sense for your pooch.

How late is too late to pick up?

Since my household gets up at 4am, we shoot for bedtime around 8pm. If you cannot pick up your pup before that point I recommend having them stay another night and being picked up or dropped off the next day. This is especially true if you are flying in as your flight may be delayed and cause additional stress and scrambling at the last minute to make arrangements. If you do plan for a late pick up, I highly recommend having a friend "on call" to pick up if you run into any emergencies.

How early is too early to drop off?

Weekday drop offs can occur as early as 4:30am, however, since I leave for work at 5:30am, it doesn't leave your dog much time to acclimate to a new environment before being left alone in it. If it is your dog's first visit with me, I definitely recommend dropping off after 10am so I can be home for the day with them. Saturday drop offs can occur at daycare after 3pm when I am finished with work. No Sunday drop offs or pick ups please.

Is my dog eligible for care in your home?

I open my home primarily to clients of daycare whose dogs know me and can attend work with me, however, I occasionally bring dogs who do not attend daycare to my home as well if they meet the following specifications

- 1) Fully potty trained
- 2) They can be left alone in my home for several hours without damaging it
- 3) They are up to date on all their vaccinations
- 4) They are friendly and gentle with other dogs, people, and children and have no history of injuring another dog or person.

Risks-

Anytime a dog visits a body of water they are at increased risk of disease or parasite. Although many dogs visit water all the time without trouble, please research the risks and make an educated choice about your dog's health and wellness. I will, of course do my best to mitigate all risks to the dogs in my care, they will be supervised, and I have been doing this many years without incident. I would like to draw particular attention to Salmon poisoning which is a PNW specific parasite that uses Salmon as a host. It is linked below. If you notice any of the symptoms below in your pet after a river visit, please take them to the vet and have them tested.

Questionnaire!

In order to provide the best care possible for you pet, please let me know the following

Feeding amounts and timing?

Wake up and Dinner-- flexible but approximately 5:00 am and 5:00 pm. 1 scoop in the AM and 2 scoops in the PM.

Medications and supplements (if any)?

None.

Does your dog have any allergies or physical restrictions?

No

Is your dog reactive on leash?

Yes- she can be a little leash aggressive with other dogs when she is on a leash.

What do you do with your dog when you leave them unsupervised in your own home?

She has free reign of the house. I believe she mostly sleeps on our guest bed all day.

What would you like me to with your dog if they are left unsupervised in my home?

She should be inside but otherwise she is ok to be free. She does steal food-- so either no food out on the counter or deny her access to a room where she can reach food.

Does your dog enjoy car rides and running errands or would they prefer to stay home unless being transported to and from your home/daycare?

She is happy to stay at home. I don't think she dislikes errands but she does not require them.

Will your dog be allowed on the lower property off leash? Would you prefer they do not visit the lower property even on leash?

She is ok off leash where there are natural boundaries.

Would your dog enjoy hiking if the opportunity presents itself? If so, would you prefer they be kept on leash or leave that to my discretion?

She is probably fine on a hike. You can use your discretion for off leash. But she might take off if she sees any critters.

Is there anything else I should know about the care of your dog?

She is not good with cats. She is obsessed with them but she has never had the chance to get close. I worry that she might be aggressive. We have no evidence or experience of that happening but her obsession makes us nervous that she wouldn't be nice to a cat.
